

CFAS MOON OBSERVING CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

CFAS has chosen to use the Moon Observing Society's program for its **ALS Study and Observing Certificate** Program. To qualify for this certificate CFAS members must complete the program as established by the Moon Observing Society. Upon completion of the program members must submit their package to the CFAS observing chairman who will then submit it to the Moon Observing Society. CFAS will pay all submission costs. When received, a Moon Observing Society Certificate will be presented to the member at a CFAS general meeting.

The following materials are to be used in completing this certificate program:

1. Overview of the program (Moon Society Lunar Study and Observing Certificate.pdf)
2. Geologic Processes On The Moon (Lunar Geology.pdf)
3. Geological Processes on the Moon Test (Geology test.pdf)
4. Observation Log (LunerCertificateLog.pdf)

To earn the ALS Study and Observing Certificate one must complete the following steps:

1. **Read the article "Geologic Processes On The Moon"**
2. **Complete an 'open book' test** over the article "Geologic Processes On The Moon" (note: this is not a difficult test; it is only designed to ensure that the article was read). Passing score occurs at 80% correct answers.
3. **Observe a list of provided objects**, and keep a log of what was seen. Only 90% of these objects (81 out of 90) need observed to complete this requirement.
4. **Mail both the test and a copy of your log** , along with a check for \$8 (processing fee) to the Moon Society.
